About the Galway Cycle

- Established in 1987 by students at St. Patrick's College, Maynooth to raise money for charity.
- First cycle from Maynooth to Galway and back comprised eight cyclists and one support car!
- In excess of €1 million raised since inception for a host of charities.
- Volunteer led and managed so costs are kept to an absolute minimum.

The 2019 Galway Cycle

- The 2019 Galway Cycle will take place between Friday 5th and Sunday 7th April 2019.
- Up to 250 cyclists are expected to participate.
- More than 60 volunteers will form a support crew for health and safety, transport, catering, bicycle repair and first aid at 6 individual pit-stops between Maynooth and Galway.
- Over 350 street collectors will be in Galway on Saturday 6th April for the chosen charity
- Regular group training sessions prior to the race.
- Sponsorship is vital to help us reach our goal of keeping costs to an absolute minimum.



Our Charity Partner for 2019: Vision Sports Ireland

- We aim to raise €100,000 to enable Vision Sports Ireland to develop a multi-sport Youth Inclusion Games that will introduce 1500 blind/vision impaired youth and children to sport over three years. The plan is to roll this out to 9 regional venues.
- Vision Sports is unique in that it is the only organisation in Ireland solely dedicated to promoting sport and leisure for vision impaired children and adults. It allows blind people to participate fully in, and derive health benefits from, sport, including tandem cycling, athletics, equestrian, tennis and more.
- Children are introduced to a range of sports early to assist them with identifying the activities they may participate in for life, for leisure or up to elite competition.





Vision Sports Ireland (VSI) is the National Governing Sport body for vision impaired people in Ireland. The charity is a not for profit organisation founded in 1988 and is run by the Board of Directors all of whom are volunteers.

The project we are helping to deliver

Of 8,000 registered blind/vision impaired youth and children in Ireland just 900 (15%) are understood to participate in sport (national average for this age group is 32%).

The Vision Sports Youth Inclusion Games aims to increase levels by 166% to an overall 2400 participants in three years (an amazing 40% overall participation level).

This will be achieved by hosting 9 regional Youth Inclusion Games in 3 years as follows: 2019 Limerick, Sligo and Kerry; 2020 Westmeath, Galway and Cork; 2021 Kilkenny, Waterford and Louth. Each event will attract 300 youth and school children (45% able-bodied, 55% vision impaired).

Funds will be used for transport of students from school gate to central venue plus return; venue hire; competition and event costs; coaching and administrative expenses; programme management; food; Vision Sports Youth Inclusion Games promotion; commemorative medals, general adaptive equipment costs (tennis balls, tandem hire, guide tethers, sound balls etc.).

To enable blind and vision impaired people to participate fully in sport and recreational activities of their choice.
